DINING HALLS

- **ARML meals will be served in Findlay/Johnston Commons. The only meals included are breakfast and lunch Saturday, May 30. The times are as follows:**

- The meal card issued to you at check-in will admit you to all meals.
- A shirt and shoes must be worn in the dining hall. You may eat as much as you want but should not waste or remove food from the dining room.
- If you lose your meal card, report it to your coach. A replacement card will be issued.

POLICIES

Established policies and rules are designed to help all students and guests receive maximum benefit from their visit. Violation of any of these rules could result in immediate dismissal.

- Students are required to be punctual and participate in all scheduled activities.
- Students are prohibited from entering residence halls other than their own unless they are chaperoned by an adult.
- Disruptive or abusive behavior that could escalate to harmful actions is forbidden.
- Misuse or damage of University property is unacceptable. Students will be charged for damage to any University facilities or equipment.
- Students are expected to demonstrate respect for, and tolerance of, each other as well as all University staff members and visitors.
- Illegal substances and alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. In addition, gambling and tobacco use are also not permitted in any University facility.

RESIDENCE HALLS

- Inspect your assigned room and living area for any damages that occurred prior to your occupancy. Notify your coach immediately of any residence hall damages or concerns. This will assure that you are not charged for these damages.
- Unauthorized room changes are not permitted.
- Always lock your door and keep your key with you at all times. If you lose your key, contact your coach/chaperone immediately. **DO NOT WAIT!** A replacement key will be issued at an additional cost.
- The residence halls will be locked at all times. All students and coaches/chaperones are expected to be in the residence halls by 11:00pm. Lights out by midnight.
- The University will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Rooms, doorways, hallways, lobbies, bath facilities and exits should be kept clean and free of obstructions.
- Trash should be placed in the container in the janitor's closet. Penn State recycles.
- Fire extinguishers are for emergencies only. In case of a fire, remain calm and proceed to the nearest exit. The staff in the building will respond to alarms.
- Elevators are to be used only for guests housed above the 3rd floor.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pay telephones for long distance calls are located in the residence hall lobby and in the Findlay/Johnston Commons Building.

- The outdoor pool is available for swimming from 10:30am to 9:00pm May 28 – 30. Additional pool passes are available from **Michael Curry, ARML Site Director**. Swim only during approved times and may not intrude on scheduled activities.
