Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The College Board and the SAT[®] Program fully support the American Regions Mathematics League (ARML) in its efforts to promote strong mathematics education in American schools and through your annual national competition.

Students are encouraged to register for a test date that won't interfere with competitive events in which they might participate. However, if students are already registered for the June test and then subsequently learn that they have been accepted into the competition that conflicts with their registered test date, they can ask their school officials to request an alternate test date. The attached flyer outlines the procedures for doing so.

As noted in the flyer, students must already be registered for an SAT administration to request an alternate test date. The registration dates on the back of the flyer reflect original dates that have now been extended: the June 5 deadline is May 5, 2010.

Thank you for all you do to expand the horizons of students pursuing the study of mathematics.
